



## Make Our Garden Grow

### How to take part as a Singer

What we are after from you is a video with soundtrack – something that most people can do very easily with the aid of two devices and a set of headphones. You will need some sheet music and a midi version of your part.

#### Time signatures

The piece alternates between 3/2 time and 'cut common time' (see symbol below)



Where you see 'cut common time' time signature symbol as above – these bars are in 2/2 and we are counting them in 2 (minims).

#### How do I do it?

You will need 2 'devices' and a set of headphones: one device for playback and one device for recording.

- Device 1 will be your Playing Device. It will be loaded with either the midi track or MP3 for playback
- Device 2 will be your Recording Device (for video/audio recording) – most smartphones, tablets or digital cameras will do this for you
- A set of headphones that you will plug in to Device 1

Get Device 2 ready to film yourself.

Attach the headphones to Device 1; press play and then play along with the track videoing yourself as you go.

#### Choral Learning Track - Notes

We have scored the vocal parts for 2 soloists and 5-part chorus – SATB with an extra part called 'Simple' which can be sung by anyone (high or low voice) who is slightly nervous of the other parts.

If you have sung *Candide* before – feel free to sing the part you know – we haven't changed the structure of the chorus. We have:

- kept the main two solo parts (Candide and Cunegonde)
- condensed the solo characters from 6 to 2 and given some of the music for the minor solo characters to the chorus.
- we have condensed the original chorus parts from 8 parts to 4 parts.

All choral learning tracks (SAT&B) start at bar 38

The click track runs throughout all learning tracks



When you focus your camera – try and get mostly your face – in good light.
